- Manage manufacturing documentation required for product manufacturing i.e. relevant drawing, BOM, accurate
  work instructions, workmanship standards and process procedures
- Use manufacturing data to monitor, measure and improve the processes
- Continually monitor, develop and improve the incoming Inspection function
- Organize meetings with other team members to facilitate growth and development
- Identify ways to reduce production costs through value engineering and recommendations i.e. new process equipment, equipment justification to improve performance
- Work with design engineering on DFX (design for excellence) to include:
  - Design for cost
  - Design for test
  - Design for manufacturability
  - o Design for assembly
- Work with other relevant departments to determine estimated costs, run time, cost reduction and close the feedback loop
- Liaise with suppliers on manufacturing process
- Train and supervise staff on new development processes and technology
- Establish a training and quality culture
- Other duties as delegated by your manager.
